Aid Still Required (ASR) - 501c3 non-profit organization founded in 2005 (EIN 26-1903008).

Mission: To create self-sufficiency in marginalized communities that have been left behind after natural disasters and human crises.

Program Areas:

- Indonesia and Sri Lanka (2004 tsunami)
- Darfur (Sudan genocide)
- New Orleans (Hurricane Katrina)
- Haiti (2010 earthquake)

ASR Operations:

- Past 13 years focused on Haiti's least secure communities.
- Serving 4,000 children and adults (including 1,000 orphans) in seven villages.
- ASR's Whole Community Approach

Three-pronged strategy lifting communities as a whole and engendering self-sufficiency:

- a. 5 K-6 schools (about 1,000 students, almost none of whom would be educated without this program).
- b. In-home medical care for all community members (about 4,000 people, most of whom had never seen a medical professional before).
- c. In-home and group social services for all community members (transforming Haiti's pervasive in-home and public violence).

Results:

- Due to ASR's ongoing weekend and in-class teacher training programs, Aid Still Required's grammar school graduates attending regional middle and high schools test significantly higher than their peers in the district, with ASR-educated girls out-performing the boys.
- Teen pregnancies down 60%.
- Hypertension (and by extension its related diseases) cut in half.
- Domestic violence markedly reduced.

Efficiency:

- A true 100% of all donations go directly to Haiti, to ASR's 82 all-Haitian team of teachers, trainers, doctors, nurses and social workers serving in their own communities. No US-based ASR personnel receive compensation in any form, and the ASR Board of Directors covers all US-based expenses.
- Cost per participant is less than \$50 per year (less than 14¢ per day), providing K-6 education (including English classes, computer training, tutoring, summer school, Saturday Children's Club, school uniforms, books and supplies, plus medical care and social services for all community members).

Why Haiti?

Haiti has a long, 532-year history of inhuman oppression. It has never recovered from slavery itself nor from the trade embargoes and all-consuming debt forced upon it after it won its freedom from Napoleon's army in 1804.

Today Haitians are experiencing their most challenging and desperate period since slavery, terrorized daily by marauding gangs that kill, lynch, kidnap, and sexually assault at will. Gangs also control food, water, medical supplies, and traffic, strangling Haiti's already abject commerce and health services.

And no one is stepping in to help.

For us at Aid Still Required, this is a rallying cry. We serve more than 4,000 of Haiti's most insecure people. Our goal is to serve 25,000 by the end of 2025 and 100,000 by the end of 2030. With our infrastructure now fully operational, and by employing economies of scale, this can be accomplished easily, village by village, with the help of generous people like yourselves

Haiti Facts:

- Haiti is the **poorest country in the Western Hemisphere** for most of the past 100 years. **Almost all Haitians live in utter poverty**, subsisting on \$1-2/day, living in makeshift huts without electricity, water, or sanitation.
- Haitians have endured **centuries of subjugation** through brutal slavery, murderous dictators, punishing trade blockades, and massive debt ever since Columbus set foot in 1492 and enslaved its people.
- Pervasive governmental corruption is supported by international drug and arms cartels.
- **Rival gangs effectively rule the country,** controlling Haiti through violence, atrocities, and restritiong the flow of food, water, medical supplies, and commerce.
- Fewer than 8% of Haitians graduate from high school, and fewer than 1% graduate from university; almost all graduates are from the top 10% economic bracket.
- The United Nations found that almost 50% of the populace currently suffers from acute food insecurity. Few Haitians eat more than one small meal per day, and many eat only a few meals per week.
