# BACKGROUND

Reading Radio 4RPH is a not-for-profit community radio station that brings the world of print to our listening audience in the greater Brisbane area. The population we serve may not be able, or choose not to read printed material, due to age, disability, literacy problems, or simply a busy lifestyle.

We are a unique radio reading service, using a wide variety of printed and online material which includes: daily newspapers, online news services, magazines, books, and journals as the basis for our programs.

Reading Radio combines the immediacy and convenience of radio with the depth of information normally found in printed material. This service is a highly effective and accessible means of closing the information gap many people experience.



## THE PROJECT

Reading Radio is heavily dependent on grants for operational income. Balancing the books has been a significant challenge over the last few years. The station produces over fifty hours of radio program content each week. The recording, editing, and production of this audio are done by our three producers who are vision impaired. With only twenty-three hours of production wages funded per week, we are often stretched to capacity. This limits our ability to source and produce new programs for the station. In addition, stress levels are high, which impacts the workplace.



With the generous donation received from the Ubuntu Foundation, we will now be able to increase the hours for our production studios to meet capacity during busy periods.
